## **Graduate Leadership Development Programme**

Telecom's Graduate Leadership Development Programme is designed to develop the specific skills and abilities of Individual graduates while providing them with a broad view of how our business operates and where they might like to develop their careers within it. The key elements of our programme include:

- Managed role rotations throughout the business
- Allocation of a senior business mentor
- Regular structured training and development sessions through the programme

Each year we bring onboard up to 10 graduates to participate in our Graduate Leadership Development Programme. The programme runs for 24 months and during this time each graduate is placed in three or four jobs across our group of companies - all with real accountability and responsibility. ### Induction

Initially, you'll participate in an induction session giving you and the other graduates:

- a full overview of our business and the wider industry
- the chance to meet the heads of our key business units to gain an insight into their view of the challenges and opportunities they face
- the chance to meet and talk with current and past graduates

### **Role Rotations**

You'll be placed into a role within the business tailored to your specific skills and areas of interest. Your role rotations are all about stretching you - you'll be placed in areas you never would have thought of before entering the programme, and perform tasks you've never trained for. It is all designed to give you a better understanding of broad business tasks - and to see what you're really capable of!

## **Development and Training**

Ongoing development is a key part of our culture at Telecom. Every graduate will be paired with a mentor from our senior leadership group who will provide advice on how to succeed and develop within Telecom.

You'll also take part in monthly progress checks with your line manager, and have more formal reviews of your performance and development each quarter.

You'll receive formal ongoing feedback as to how you are performing in your roles as well as ongoing career development guldance. There will also be up to three training courses a year as part of the programme to develop your skills in areas such as:

- managing people
- persuasive presentation
- influencing others

After your two years on the programme you'll be able to develop your career in the same way as all Telecom employees. Based on your experiences you can decide on the area within the business you'd like to specialise in.


